AN ACT Relating to Water Sets in Trapping Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 70, amended. The first sentence of section 70 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

‘Any person trapping in any organized or incorporated place shall visit each trap or cause the same to be visited at least once in every calendar day including Sunday, except beaver sets, so called, and **waters sets**, and remove therefrom or cause to be removed any animal found caught therein.’
