RESOLVE, Opening Portland Lake in Aroostook County to Ice Fishing for Salmon and Trout.

Portland Lake; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Portland Lake, situated in the Town of Bridgewater, Aroostook County, to ice fishing for the taking of salmon and trout during the legal season.
