## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Audience or Reader Participation in Radio, Television or Newspaper Amusements or Games.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 139, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 139 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 16 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 28. Audience or reader participation in radio, television or newspaper amusements or games. Nothing contained in this chapter shall apply to or prohibit the conducting or operating over television or radio or by newspaper publication with audience or reader participation of any amusement, game or program, whether or not the same involves the awarding of prizes or the element of chance, provided the participants pay no consideration in cash or other property directly or indirectly for the privilege of participating therein.'
