## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 99th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 117, L. D. 267, Bill, "An Act

Creating the Portland Coliseum Recreation Center."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 13th and 14th lines of section 1, the following words and punctuation: "or exercise of the right of eminent domain as hereinafter provided,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th lines of section 2 the following: "and is expressly granted the right of eminent domain, and for the purposes of this act is authorized to take and hold, either by exercising its right of eminent domain as herein provided, or"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 3 and 4 thereof.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 8 the following paragraph:

'Anything in this section to the contrary notwithstanding, the said board of trustees may not incur any indebtedness, other than current or operating expenses, by bond issue or otherwise in excess of an original amount of \$3,500,000, except by and with the express approval of the voters of said district at a referendum or special election advertised, conducted and called in accordance with the law relating to municipal elections. Procedure regarding the registration of voters prior to such special election or referendum shall be the same as that hereinafter set forth governing such procedure preparatory to the special election to be called on the question of the approval of this act.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 to be sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, respectively.
