IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Compensate William H. Barker of Waterford for Injuries While Training with National Guard.

William H. Barker, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to compensate William H. Barker of Waterford for injuries sustained while training with the National Guard in Connecticut.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

William H. Barker entered Connecticut Field Hospital on August 10, 1913 with a bad hip injury incurred while training with the National Guard at Hartford, Connecticut. He had to give up his carpenter work and has had trouble with his hip since the injury. He is 74 years old.
