STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting Town Officials of Freeport to be Nominated by Political Caucus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Nomination of town officials in Freeport. In addition to the method prescribed by the Revised Statutes, chapter 90-A, section 37, subsection III, the nomination for any office in the Town of Freeport may be made by political caucus. All certificates of political caucus nominations shall be signed by the chairman and secretary of the caucus.

All provisions of chapter 90-A, section 37, as far as applicable, shall apply to this act.
