# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Exhibiting Hunting Licenses on Request.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 73, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 73 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:
  - 'II. Any resident over 16 years of age may hunt wild birds and animals provided he has first procured from the commissioner or his authorized agent a written license which shall be kept on the person while hunting or transporting birds, or parts thereof, and animals, or parts thereof, and which shall be exhibited to any warden, employee of this the department or , guide or owner or lessee of land upon which the licensee is engaged in the activity of, or proceeding to or from, hunting, or the agent of such owner or lessee, upon request.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 73, sub-V, amended. The first paragraph of subsection V of section 73 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'Any nonresident over 12 years of age may hunt wild birds and animals provided he has first procured from the commissioner or his authorized agent a written license which shall be kept on the person while hunting or transporting birds, or parts thereof, and animals, or parts thereof, and which shall be exhibited to any warden, employee of this the department of, guide or owner or lessee of land upon which the licensee is engaged in the activity of, or proceeding to or from, hunting, or the agent of such owner or lessee, upon request.'
