### **RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Narrows Pond, Kennebec County.**

---

**Fishing in Narrows Pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Narrows Pond, in the Town of Winthrop, Kennebec County, to ice fishing for all fish except bass during February and March. There shall be a daily bag limit of 5 trout, salmon and togue in the aggregate which shall not exceed a weight of  $7\frac{1}{2}$  pounds in the aggregate.
