**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in the West Branch of Pleasant River,
Piscataquis County.**

Fishing in the West Branch of Pleasant River; regulated. Resolve: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the West Branch of the Pleasant River in Piscataquis County to fishing under the general law, except there shall be a daily bag limit of 10 trout in that portion of the river from the Gulf Hagus to First West Branch Pond.
