#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Power of Municipalities in Collection of Personal Property Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 22, § 61, amended. Section 61 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 121 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 61. Licenses issued when poll tax paid. No person required by law to pay a poll tax and personal property taxes in this State shall be granted a license to operate a motor vehicle until he shall present a receipt or certificate that he has paid his last assessed poll tax and personal property taxes in the town where he resided or written evidence from the taxing authority of that town that he was legally exempted therefrom or that the tax has been abated.'
