AN ACT Relating to Qualified Assistant Pharmacists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 68, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 68 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by sections 5, 6 and 7 of chapter 304 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

‘Every person who is the holder of a certificate as a qualified assistant pharmacist, issued prior to July 1, 1960, shall be admitted to the registered pharmacist examination prior to July 1, 1971, provided he has held such certificate for at least 10 years and shall have been actively engaged in retail or hospital practice of pharmacy for at least 3 years immediately prior to his application for the registered pharmacist examination. Any such applicant who fails in 2 such examinations shall not be allowed to take any further examinations.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 68, § 7, repealed. Section 7 of chapter 68 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 304 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 1960.
