AN ACT Relating to Lights on Rear of Certain Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 43, amended. The last paragraph of section 43 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 314 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'All lights, reflectors and signal lamps required by law to be displayed on the rear of all motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers of 7 feet or over in width shall be at least within 12 inches of the extreme extension of the rear of such vehicle **except that on flat-body, dump trucks of 7 feet or over in width such lights, reflectors and signal lamps may be displayed on the rear of the frame of the vehicle.**'
