STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to License Plates for Disabled or Paraplegic Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. The last 2 paragraphs of section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'All registrations of vehicles, all certificates of registrations and number plates shall terminate and become void at midnight on the 31st day of December of each year, except as provided for in section 18.

Any veteran who has lost both legs or the use of both legs and who has registered his motor vehicle without the payment of a fee as provided in this section, upon certification by the Veterans Administration, shall be issued special designating plates to be used in addition to the regular registration plates. Such designating plates shall be issued by the secretary of state upon certification by the Veterans Administration. The registration plates so issued shall bear the initial "V" before the plate number.

All registrations of vehicles, all certificates of registrations and number plates shall terminate and become void at midnight on the 31st day of December of each year, except as provided for in section 18.
