STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Norridgewock for Aid to Family of Roger A. Jones.

Town of Norridgewock; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$375.90 to be paid to the Town of Norridgewock to reimburse it for aid given to the family of Roger A. Jones.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Town of Norridgewock is asking for reimbursement for aid given to the family of Roger A. Jones from April, 1956 to February 20th, 1958. This family was accepted by the Department of Health and Welfare as state paupers on May 20th, 1958, but they would not reimburse the town for any bills more than 3 months old.
