SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 129, L. D. 324, Bill, "An Act
Directing a Study of Property Tax Administration."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of
section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The State Tax Assessor is authorized to employ such technical
and clerical assistance as may be necessary to conduct such study.
The Governor shall appoint an advisory committee of not more than
12 persons to assist in such study. The advisory committee shall
choose its own chairman.'
