**AN ACT Pertaining to Discontinuance of Portions of County Roads When
Reconstructed.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 42-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 42-A, as follows:

'Sec. 42-A. Discontinuance of portions of county roads when reconstructed. When the State Highway Department has constructed a highway over substantially the same route as that of a county road and has recorded the plans of same in the registry of deeds, the county commissioners may, on their own motion, after notice and hearing, proceed to alter or discontinue the portion of said county road not within the limits of said highway. They shall give notice and proceed as provided in sections 36, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 42 and any aggrieved person shall have an appeal as therein provided. The plans prepared by the State Highway Department and on record in the registry of deeds may be referred to in describing those portions of the county road to be discontinued.'
