IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Repealing Bounty on Bobcat, Loupcervier and Canada Lynx.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 121, repealed. Section 121 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed.
