AN ACT Relating to Property Tax Exemption of Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ III, ¶ E-1, additional. Subsection III of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section one of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new paragraph following paragraph E, to be numbered E-1, to read as follows:

'E-1. When a person eligible for exemption under this section owns real and personal property in any place with a total assessed valuation in that place in excess of the exemption there applicable, the exemption shall be applied first to personal property.'
