RESOLVE, Authorizing Use of Passamaquoddy Trust Funds for Housing.

Passamaquoddy trust funds for housing; authorizing use. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Welfare be, and hereby is, authorized to use \$80,000 of the Passamaquoddy tribe trust funds to provide new housing for the reservation at Pleasant Point; and be it further

Resolved: That the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is, authorized to purchase for the General Fund of the State, at par not to exceed \$80,000 of the bonds of the United States of America now owned by the Trust Fund of the Passamaquoddy Indians.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Passamaquoddy reservation at Pleasant Point is in dire need of houses. It is felt that the method proposed by this Resolve will allow the building of houses without using General Fund revenue. The money can be replaced over a period of years by turning back to the trust funds the net income from the sale of timber.
