AN ACT Relating to Examination for Real Estate Broker's or Salesman's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 5, amended. The last paragraph of section 5 of chapter 84 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The commission is authorized to require every applicant for a first-time broker's license or a first-time salesman's license to appear in person at such time and place as the commission shall designate for that purpose, for a personal written ~~or oral~~ examination as to his qualifications to act as a broker or salesman, and the commission shall collect a fee of \$10 for such examination, which fee will entitle any applicant for a license to one retake examination, without additional charge, should the applicant fail to pass the first examination. The examination fee ~~provided herein~~ shall be in addition to any other fees authorized by this chapter.'
