AN ACT Permitting Municipalities to Enter into Collective Bargaining Contracts with Labor Unions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 5-A, additional. Chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 5-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Bargaining contracts with labor unions. A municipality may recognize unions of employees and make and enter into collective bargaining contracts with such unions.'
