**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Copies of Constitution of Maine.**

---

**Copies of Constitution of Maine; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to the Department of Education from the Un-appropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 for the purchase of 20,000 copies of the Constitution of Maine.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

These materials would permit compliance with Section 144-A of Chapter 41, R. S., 1954, which requires instruction in the American freedoms, including the Constitution of Maine, in grades 11 or 12 in all public schools.
