## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement for Professional Credits Obtained by Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 237-B, amended. The first sentence of section 237-B of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 364 and as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Whenever any certified teacher completes, within any 2-year period, 6 credit hours of additional professional work approved by the commissioner and receives supplementary financial assistance in an amount not less than \$50 \$100 from an administrative unit, said unit shall receive reimbursement of \$50 \$100 from the State for such expenditure at the next distribution of state funds.'
