AN ACT Relating to Snow Removal from Controlled Access Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 68, amended. The last paragraph of section 68 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 46 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'The maintenance provisions of sections 66, 67, 68, 79, 80, 82 and 87 shall not apply to those compact or built up sections of state highway in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 5,000 inhabitants, except ~~as hereinafter provided~~ for maintenance of secondary federal aid projects, and the snow removal provisions shall not apply to those compact or built up sections and "compact areas" as determined by the commission, in which compact sections are intermittent and separated by a short interval or intervals of sections that are not compact of state highway, **or to controlled access highways**, in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 2,000 inhabitants.'
