AN ACT Relating to Dating Processed Milk.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 120-A, additional. Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 120-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 120-A. Dating of processed milk. Whoever, not a producer of milk, whose principal business is the processing for sale at wholesale or retail of any grade or kind of milk shall distinctly print on the outside or cap of each container used in marketing such milk, the date such milk was produced. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500.'
