STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Providing for the Remodeling of Wingate Hall at the University of Maine in Orono.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Wingate Hall, remodeling of. The University of Maine is authorized to remodel Wingate Hall on its Orono Campus.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Maine from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$55,000 to carry out the provisions of this act.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. The basement and first floor of Wingate Hall will be vacated by the Physics Department when it moves into the Physics Building (now under construction) in the summer of 1959.

2. The basement will provide enlarged space for the Soils Laboratory now crowded into a partial basement in Lord Hall.

3. The first floor now used as physics laboratories will be converted to general classroom and office use for the expanding departments of the university.
