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**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Jackson for Aid to Louise M. Tilton.**

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**Town of Jackson; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,066.87 to be paid to the Town of Jackson to reimburse said town for aid given to Louise M. Tilton, state pauper.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Tilton did not have a settlement and the State paid for her support until December 10, 1955. Then she married Clair Tilton and she is now at Pownal. The town contends that Mrs. Tilton never acquired a settlement in Jackson.
