AN ACT Relating to Gas Masks for Fire Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 97, § 3-A, additional. Chapter 97 of the Revised Statutes as amended by adding a new section 3-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 3-A. Gas masks. Each municipality, corporation or individual providing fire protection shall supply each vehicle responding to a fire with a gas mask for use by the members of the fire department when required to enter any place where the supply of oxygen may be insufficient to sustain human life. Such masks shall meet the requirements of the standards set up by the United States Bureau of Mines.'
