IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Widows and Children of Deceased Policemen of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 21, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 21 of Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as repealed and replaced by chapter 120 of the private and special laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'If a member of the Lewiston police department should die, whether he is retired or on active duty, or as a result of injury received in the line of duty, his widow, or, if none, his minor child or children shall continue to receive the pension he was receiving at the time of his death.'
