STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Exempting the Grange from Property Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ II, ¶ E-1, additional. Subsection II of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new paragraph following paragraph E, to be numbered E-1, to read as follows:
 - 'E-1. The real estate and personal property owned and occupied or used solely for its own purposes by the Maine State Grange or by any incorporated subordinate grange.'
