## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Number and Compensation of Special Deputy Sheriffs in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 173, amended. Section 173 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 173. Special deputies in Cumberland County; compensation. The sheriff of Cumberland County shall appoint 3 full time deputy sheriffs, who shall serve at the pleasure of said sheriff and whose special duty shall be to enforce the criminal laws in said county and who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of \$\\$ \$13 per day and such additional pay as the county commissioners may approve, to be paid from the county treasury, together with such incidental expenses as may be necessary for the proper enforcement of said laws; bills for which shall be audited as provided in section 2 of chapter 150, section 2.
