## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 99th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 284, L. D. 431, Bill, "An Act to Regulate Privately Owned Correspondence Schools."

Amend said Bill by adding after the 4th sentence of that part designated "Sec. 183-A" the following underlined sentences:

"The liability of the surety on such bond for each representative covered thereby shall, in no event, exceed the sum of \$1,000 as an aggregate for any and all students for all breaches of the conditions of the bond by such representatives. The surety on any such bond may cancel any such bond upon giving 30 days' notice in writing to the State Board of Education and thereafter shall be relieved of liability for any breach of condition occurring after the effective date of said cancellation."

Further amend said Bill in the 5th sentence of that part designated "Sec. 183-A" by inserting before the period at the end the following underlined punctuation and words:

", if a continuous bond has not been furnished"
