STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Fishing and Hunting Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ V-A, additional. Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection V-A, to read as follows:

'V-A. Nonresident fishing licenses shall not be sold outside the State of Maine, except by a state agency.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37, § 73, sub-§ V-A, additional. Section 73 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection V-A, to read as follows:

'V-A. Nonresident hunting licenses shall not be sold outside the State of Maine, except by a state agency.'
