STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pari Mutuel Pools for Running Horse Races.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 87, § 13, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 13 of chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 391 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Commissions on such pools shall in no event and at no track exceed 17% of each dollar wagered, plus the odd cents of all redistribution to be based on each dollar wagered exceeding a sum equal to the next lowest multiple of 10, known as "breakage," 40% of which breakage shall be retained by the licensee and the balance shall be paid to the Treasurer of State.'
