STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Amount of Property Held by West Oxford Agricultural Society.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1851, c. 449, § 2, repealed and replaced. Section 2 of chapter 449 of the private and special laws of 1851 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 2. Amount of property; disposition of income. Said society is established within the Towns of Hiram, Porter, Brownfield, Denmark, Fryeburg, Lovell, Stow, Sweden, Waterford and Stoneham, and may take and hold property, real or personal, not exceeding in value at any one time \$200,000, the annual income of which shall be applied exclusively to the advancement of agriculture and the mechanic arts connected therewith.'

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
