RESOLVE, in Favor of Miss Margaret Crosby of Bangor.

Margaret Crosby; retirement credit. Resolved: That Miss Margaret Crosby, of Bangor, be given credit for 19 years' teaching service at the Somerset School during the years 1912 to 1931 and that said prior service credit shall be added to any other teaching service in the State of Maine for purposes of determining her final retirement benefits under the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, as enacted by the public laws of 1955, chapter 417, section 1.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Crosby from September, 1912 to June, 1931 had teaching service at the Somerset School. Such school is not considered a public one for the purpose of retirement benefits and therefore Miss Crosby has never received credit for this teaching service.
