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

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Cumberland County, as last amended by section 3 of chapter 406 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland, \$4,800 \$5,000; assistant county attorney, \$3,300 \$4,000,'

Sec. 2. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that this act shall not repeal or amend any act which may be enacted by the 99th Legislature creating a second assistant county attorney for Cumberland County.
