## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

### AN ACT Changing the Name Pauper to Indigent Person.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Amendatory clause.** Wherever in the Revised Statutes or public laws the words "pauper" or "paupers" appear, they shall mean "indigent person" or "indigent persons."
