## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Authority of Sigma Kappa Sorority to Hold Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority to hold property. Sigma Kappa Sorority, a corporation without capital stock organized in 1904 under the general laws of the State, notwith-standing the limitations thereof, is authorized to take and hold by purchase, gift, devise or bequest, personal or real estate to any amount to be used, managed and disposed of by said corporation for its proper corporate purposes, subject to the limitation that the amount of any personal and real estate held by it in any one town in the State shall not exceed 10% of that town's valuation; and subject also to the further limitation that both the principal and income of any gift, devise or bequest shall be appropriated according to the terms of such gift, devise or bequest.
