STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting Municipalities to Provide Educational Scholarships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 90-A, § 12, sub-§ III, ¶ D, additional. Subsection III of section 12 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new paragraph D, to read as follows:
 - 'D. Providing a one-year full tuition scholarship to worthy resident graduates of high schools to any Maine college or university, said scholarship not to exceed the annual tuition charge to the University of Maine.'
