AN ACT Relating to License Fees for Seeing-Eye Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 10, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 10 of chapter 100 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'In addition to the amount paid for license and tag, each applicant shall pay the city or town clerk 25c for the recording and making a return to the Commissioner of Agriculture, **except that a license and tag shall be issued by the city or town clerk, upon application, for any trained seeing-eye dog owned or kept by a blind person without payment of any fee required under this section.**'
