**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Regional Television Films to
Promote the Recreational Industry.**

Department of Economic Development; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated the sum of \$20,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Economic Development for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 to provide for promotional television films on Maine's various regional recreational areas. Said appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

More television films on Maine's recreational industry are needed to promote the various regional recreational areas in Maine.
