RESOLVE Opening Sebasticook River, Somerset, Walde and Kennebec Counties to Ice Fishing.

Sebasticook River; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Sebasticook River from Moose Pond in Hartland to its confluence with the Kennebec River in Winslow to ice fishing under the general law.
