STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Observance of Legal Holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 107, § 55, amended. Section 55 of chapter 107 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 44 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘Whenever Washington’s Birthday, February 22nd; Memorial Day, May 30th; Independence Day, July 4th; and Veterans Day, November 11th, fall on a day other than Monday, the legal holiday for such date shall be observed on the Monday nearest to said enumerated date.’

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act will become effective whenever after January 1, 1959 the Governor shall determine and by proclamation declare that 32 other states have, each by law, designated Mondays for the observance of such of the following holidays, to wit: Washington’s Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day and Veterans Day, as are legal holidays in each said state.
