## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Application of Workmen's Compensation Act to Certain Employers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 4, repealed and replaced. Section 4 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 343 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 4. Application of Workmen's Compensation Act to certain employers. Section 3 shall apply to all employers, excepting that said provisions shall not apply to actions to recover damages for the injuries provided, or for death resulting from such injuries, sustained by employees engaged in domestic service or in agriculture or engaged in casual employment.'
