SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 358, L. D. 517, Bill, "An Act Permitting Town of Fort Kent to Raise Money for Boarding Home for Aged."

Amend said Bill by striking out the period at the end and adding thereto the following:

', provided that said boarding home shall be organized under the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 54. The Town of Fort Kent shall have a lien on such boarding home equal to the amount of money appropriated and turned over in the aggregate by the Town of Fort Kent to the said boarding home, which lien may be enforced in the same manner and with the same effect as the lien on real estate set forth in the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 91-A, section 89, as enacted by the public laws of 1955, chapter 399, section 1, whenever the said boarding home ceases to be a boarding home organized under said Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 54.'
