STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT to Change the Title of Road Commissioner of the Town of Kittery and to Enlarge His Duties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Kittery; Commissioner of Public Works, duties. The Road Commissioner for the Town of Kittery shall hereafter be known as the Commissioner of Public Works, and in addition to existing duties and powers, he shall be responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of the so-called Admiralty Village Sewage System and shall be custodian of municipally-owned buildings and real estate, excepting school properties, but including municipally-owned wharves, docks and piers, under the direction of the selectmen of Kittery.
