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AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of X-ray Shoe-fitting Machines.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 137, § 20-A, additional. Chapter 137 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 20-A, to read as follows:

**'X-ray Shoe-fitting Machines.**

Sec. 20-A. X-ray shoe-fitting machines. No shoe-fitting device or machine which uses fluoroscopic, X-ray or radiation principles shall be operated or maintained. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.'
