RESOLVE, Providing Aid to Albina W. Farrell of Gardiner.

Albina W. Farrell; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and is, granted to Albina W. Farrell, of Gardiner, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Farrell is the remarried widow of a veteran and therefore no federal pension is available. Her husband has died. She is unable to work and is in need of aid.
