STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Dragging for Scallops in Bagaduce River and Bay in Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 105-A, additional. Chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 105-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 105-A. Dragging for scallops in Bagaduce River and Bay. Dragging for scallops in Bagaduce River and Bagaduce Bay, Hancock County, shall be limited to the use of 3-foot drags and only within a line drawn between Dice Head and Nautilus Island.

Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for each offense.'
